## **A TRICK OF THE LIGHT** A NEW COMEDY BY PETER MOORE Sept/Oct 2023

**SYNOPSIS:** Eddie, a middle-aged guy living a normal life, has just discovered he has the ability to vanish at will. Really. He has no idea where it came from or what to do about it, or even if he should do anything about it. His friends Marty and Darrell are impressed but not much help, and to his bafflement, he can't vanish at all in the presence of his wife Beth, so she doesn't believe him. ## **ANNE FRANK & ME** A YOUTH PRODUCTION ON THE MAINSTAGE BY CHERIE BENNETT October 2023

## **THE MOUSETRAP** THE CLASSIC MURDER MYSTERY BY AGATHA CHRISTIE Nov/Dec 2023

**SYNOPSIS:** After a local woman is murdered, the guests and staff at Monkswell Manor find themselves stranded during a snowstorm.
